



Registration for Research Option Courses: LCC4701 and LCC 4702

LCC 4701: Undergraduate Research Proposal Writing

Students should plan to complete the LCC 4701 proposal writing course during either their first or second semester of research, but no later than the semester before they plan to complete the thesis. The course will provide instruction on literature reviews, research ethics, and proposal writing, among other concepts.

Permits are required for registration. Students interested in taking the course should email the UROP office (urop@gatech.edu) requesting a permit during Phase I registration (Subject line: LCC 4701 permit). Students will be required to have submitted an [online intent form](#) and have a research advisor in place (students not already completing a term of research with their mentor should have their mentor email the UROP office certifying that they will be mentoring the student in the research option) before being issued a permit.

LCC 4702: Undergraduate Research Thesis Writing

Students should plan to complete the LCC 4702 thesis writing course during the same semester in which they write their thesis. The course provides a framework by which students are guided through the thesis-writing process. Students should be able to complete a first draft near mid-term of the semester taking the course. Ideally, primary data collection should be planned before mid-term in order to provide time to complete the thesis and any analysis by the end of the semester.

Registration for the LCC 4702 course, is available by permission only.

Items below should be submitted to the UROP office (urop@gatech.edu) during the first week of Phase I registration in order to obtain a permit for the course:

- 1) Email confirming your intent to take the course (Subject line: LCC 4702 permit).
- 2) A list of research courses you have taken (or plan to take) to satisfy the hours for the Research option including the course number, number of hours, and semester taken.
- 3) Graduation semester

Students must have completed the LCC4701 course before taking LCC 4702. Students will be granted permits in situations where they have either already completed 4701 or are currently enrolled in the 4701 course making satisfactory progress. (Proposals required for the research option will be approved by the school in which the student is planning to complete the option during a student's time in the 4701 course. The approved proposal is required before entry into LCC 4702.)

Students may submit items as late as one week before classes begin for the semester you plan to take one of the courses, *however*, a place in the class or a class meeting time that meets your individual schedule cannot be guaranteed at that point.
